THE PURPOSE OF THIS ROLE

Against the backdrop of the United Nations Decade on Ecosystem Restoration and in partnership with The Scottish Rewilding Alliance, we are planning a new feature length documentary, focusing on current attitudes in Scotland towards our ecologically depleted land and seas, and how a new generation can take inspiration from changing perspectives both here and elsewhere in Europe.

Rather than talk broadly about long-term, ecological processes, which are often so abstract they can leave an audience feeling detached and helpless, this film explores Scotland's rewilding potential at a far more personal level – through the eyes of a young Scot facing an uncertain future.

We are therefore, looking for a protagonist to front this ground-breaking film. As the lead character, we will follow you and your story, filming in Scotland and at various locations in Europe. This is a hugely exciting and equally challenging opportunity for a young Scot to speak up for a generation at a time of climate breakdown and global biodiversity loss.

We are not looking for a trained actor and you do not necessarily need experience in front of the camera. However, the successful candidate will:

- Have a sincere concern and interest in both the natural and cultural value of Scotland's landscapes. You don't need ecological expertise, but you must have a genuine willingness to search out answers to difficult questions. Can you see beyond what Scotland *does* look like and imagine what it *could* look like?
- Be believable and authentic, honest and open, passionate but measured; be able to show empathy to the plight of both people and wildlife. The audience will be your companion along an eye-opening journey. We are not looking for somebody to act the part we need you to be *real*.
- Be willing to share your vulnerabilities, emotions, fears and hopes for Scotland's future landscapes. You need to want to seek answers and solutions, and challenge or look beyond the status quo.
- Be open to the concept of rewilding and understand its potential, although you may well have questions and concerns about how it might work for everybody.
- Be aged between 18 and 27.
- Have a genuine link to, or background in, rural Scotland.
- Be willing to travel and be filmed at a number of locations across Europe during the course of a one-year filming period.
- Be willing to undertake a test filming day so we can get a measure of your suitability for the role.

This position will be awarded as a freelance contract spanning between 12-16 months.
